Logline

A forgotten hero searches for salvation through a friend who may or may not be real, as an unlikely relationship with a stray dog blossoms into a chance to rediscover purpose in a painting of his mysterious companion. But newfound hope may have painful consequences.

Synopsis

A forgotten hero living a shadow of an existence has a chance encounter with a stray dog. The dog follows him home, and a reluctant relationship develops as the man gradually begins to accept the companionship he fears but so desperately needs. Inspired by a new ray of hope, he digs out his old painting supplies and begins to paint a portrait of his new friend. As weeks pass and the painting nears completion, a sense of meaning and purpose return to his life, but the ultimate price of his newfound hope may be more than he can afford to pay.



Director's Statement

I departed my engineering career in 2000 and began taking freelance writing gigs to make ends meet. A client hired me to drive his luxury car to Traverse City, and during the trip, I began to develop a story of a burned out cop who develops a dependent relationship with a stray dog. Upon arriving at my hotel that night, I wrote a short story entitled "Painting Pllfinger" and it was eventually selected as a quarter finalist in the 2001 New Century Writers Award contest.

Thirteen years later, I decided the time was right to make my first film. I had experienced modest success producing educational and multilingual videos for toddlers. But my real passion has always been film, so when I thought about what movie I wanted to make, I kept coming back to *Painting Pilfinger*. As a first time filmmaker on a budget, the idea of finding and working with a capable dog was daunting and impractical. I had almost abandoned the adaptation when I thought of using a toy dog. This posed the challenge—or presented the opportunity depending on your perspective—to get a little creative with the film's point of view. My wife and producer, Raquel de Paula Silvius, suggested an alternate ending to the plot which would shake up the audience's perception of the toy dog, and with some minor tweaks, the screenplay materialized.

Perhaps the biggest challenge I wanted to undertake in *Painting Pilfinger* was to rely completely on cinematography and an original score to tell the story. I feel that dialogue is often a cheap and easy way to relay information and entertain an audience. My goal with *Painting Pilfinger* was to engage the audience with pure story and no discernible dialogue. If I could accomplish this, then perhaps I may have done something worthwhile cinematographically. —Bradley Silvius
